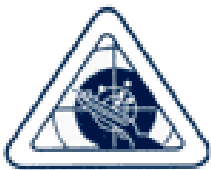


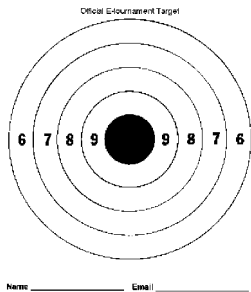
Fun with Sons at Mataguay

Registration:

Registration is available online. See the bottom of this page for the web address. The cost is \$25 per camper and can be paid online with credit card, paypal, etc.

This is a scout and guardian camp only – please no siblings or non-scouts.

Registration closes on 30-Sep-2009, so hurry, there are only 400 spots total.

During registration, make sure to properly state pack and den. They use this information to group campers from the same unit.

Getting there:

The scout ranch is located approx. one hour (by car) NE of Del Mar. The physical address is:

Checking in and setting up:

Check-in at the scout ranch officially starts at 4pm on 02-Oct-2009. It's a good idea to be there on time (or maybe even a little early). Sunset is at 6:30pm and setting up camp in the dark is not always fun.

There is an A-Frame building approx. 1 mile in on the dirt road. Stop there to check in. They will want to know your name and pack number. They will also want to see the **completed medical form** (link below; section A + C only, section B is not required) for **each** camper.

Once you have your camp site assignment – it will be the name of an animal – make your way to the camp site. A link to the map of the scout ranch is included below. The road is a clock-wise one-way-road. You might have to take the long way 'round ☺.

You can drive to the camp site and unload but you cannot park there. All cars have to be in parking lots for the night and the ranch staff is very serious about that.

Other Information:

- Please bring food for your Friday night dinner. All other meals will be provided in the open air dining hall.
- It can get pretty cold at night. Current forecast calls for nightly temperatures in the low 40s.
