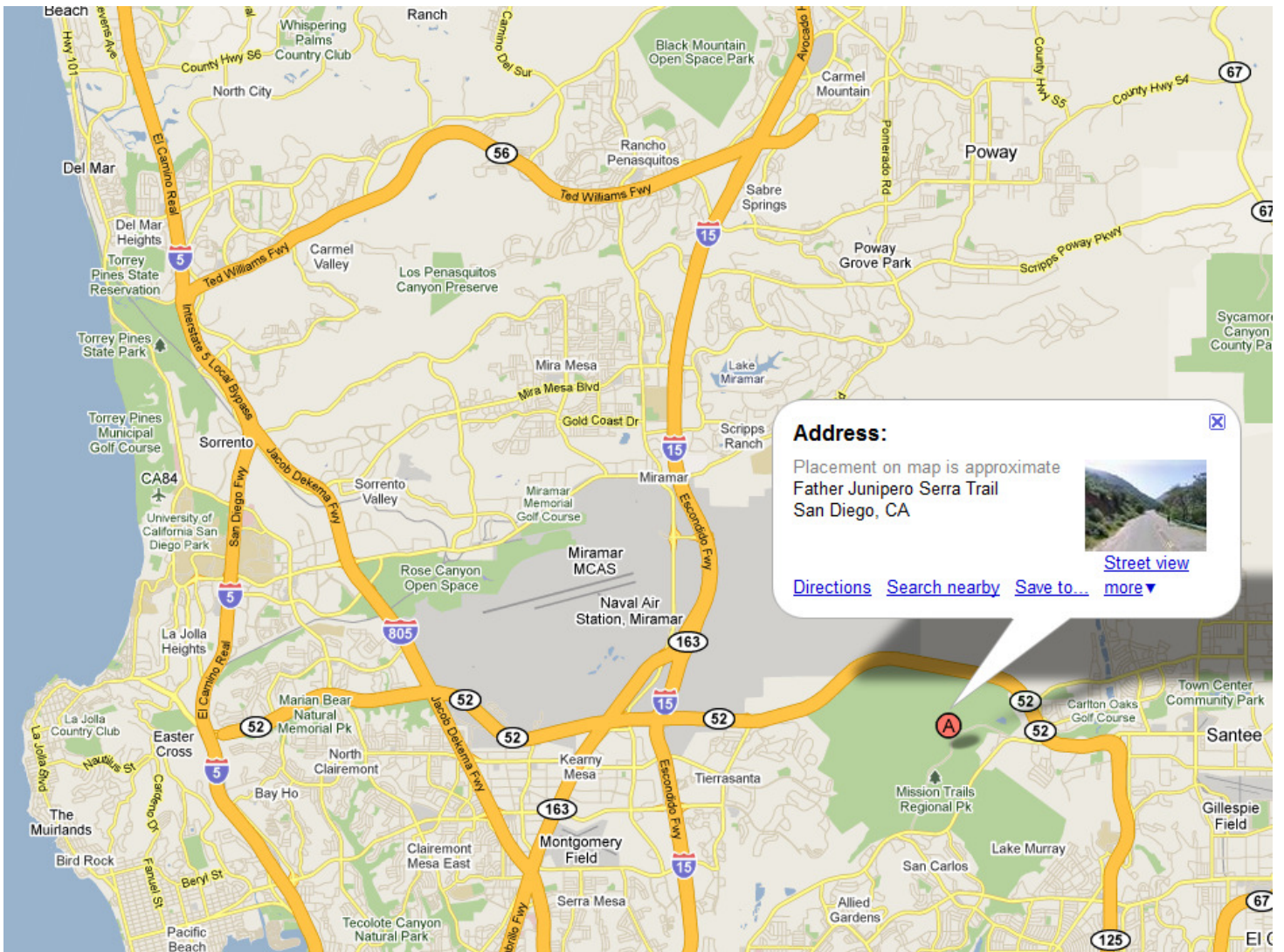

The campground is approx. 20 miles/30 minutes from Carmel Valley

- Take 52 east to the Mast Blvd. exit in Santee
- Turn left on Mast Blvd.
- Go under freeway overpass to the first traffic signal
- Turn right on West Hills Parkway
- Turn right on Mission Gorge Road
- Proceed to the right turn road that occurs just prior to the traffic signal at Father Junipero Serra Trail and turn right.
- Continue 0.2 miles.
- Kumeyaay Lake Campground is on your right.
